### **MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE TOWNSHIP BOARD**

**DECEMBER 9<sup>TH</sup> 2013**

#### **REGULAR MEETING**

The Regular Meeting of the Palos Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Schumann in the Township Hall, 10802 S. Roberts Road, Palos Hills, at 7:00 P.M. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was taken by the Supervisor Schumann in the absence of Clerk Nolan. Present were Trustees Brannigan, Lebarre, and Woods, Supervisor Schumann. Also present was Township Attorney, James Gierach.

**Supervisor Schumann** stated that a quorum of elected officials were present for voting purposes.

**Trustee Woods** moved to approve the minutes of the November 13, 2013, Regular Meeting. **Trustee Lebarre** seconded the motion. Roll call was taken. Ayes: Trustees Brannigan, Lebarre and Woods, Supervisor Schumann. Nays: None. Motion carried 4-0.

**Trustee Woods** thanked Clerk Nolan for providing the minutes in advance of the meeting.

**COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE PUBLIC:** None.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Update on the Palos Park Unincorporated Home:

**Trustee Woods** stated that the status of the home has been upgraded to "dangerous and hazadarous." When this happens the complaints will be

filed in three months instead of four. The complaints have not been filed by the State's Attorney at this date.

**Supervisor Schumann** stated that a call came into the Township from a restoration company in Indiana for information concerning the home. The residents of the home took a portion of the settlement from the fire of the home to use to come up to date with their foreclosure issues. They are hopefully moving out of foreclosure, and this company has been hired to restore their home. The home will still be cited for garbage and trash which is a big issue for the neighbors. The home is not condemned. The owner is permitted to go inside as is the insurance company to take inventory. Supervisor Schumann feels that this may be "out of our hands" following the above proceedings.

**Supervisor Schumann** reminded everyone that the Holiday Party will take place on Friday, December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2013, at Aviana Banquets in Palos Hills.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

##### **Current Press Releases:**

There are no current press releases, but Supervisor Schumann stated that the township will place a holiday greeting ad from the township in both the Regional and Reporter newspapers.

##### **Health Service Update:**

**Supervisor Schumann** informed the Board that Attorney Gierach has papers to review concerning homeless people and others in regard to various Health Service services.

**Trustee Brannigan** stated that she would like to see the Township Board hold next years levy steady. She would like to know how this can be accomplished.

**Trustee Woods** reported that the Board is looking at some economic development. They would like to work with the communities, and they feel this will help the individual tax payers. The Board would potentially like to do a real estate style "add on" to the township website. Residents and developers can go to the website and search all the available commercial
