MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE TOWNSHIP BOARD

JUNE 14TH, 2010

REGULAR MEETING

The Regular Meeting of the Palos Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Schumann in the Township Hall, 10802 S. Roberts Road, Palos Hills, at 7:00 P.M. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was taken by the Clerk of the Township, Jane Nolan. Present were Trustees Carbonara, Poulos and Ryan, Supervisor Schumann. Also present was Township Attorney, James Gierach.

Absent: Trustee Conway

Supervisor Schumann stated that a quorum of elected officials were present for voting purposes.

Trustee Ryan made the motion to approve the minutes of the May 10th, 2010, Regular Meeting. **Trustee Carbonara** seconded the motion. Roll call was taken. Ayes: Trustees Carbonara, Poulos and Ryan, Supervisor Schumann. Nays: None. Motion carried 4-0.

AUDIENCE COMMENTS: None.

OLD BUSINESS:

There were no questions concerning the Tentative Budget and Appropriations Ordinance 2010-2011 for Palos Township at this time.

Attorney Gierach stated that the draft of the 2010-2011 Budget and Appropriations Ordinance has been posted and notice of its' availability has been published.

NEW BUSINESS:

Attorney Gierach stated that a new ordinance will take affect on July 1, 2010, concerning identity protection. **Attorney Gierach** will have Palos Township's Identity Protection Act Ordinance ready for the next meeting. He informed the Board, in general, of the topics referenced in this act.

Current Press Releases

There are no current press releases at this time. Clerk Nolan circulated the Village View Newspaper to the Board members which included Palos Township's 2010 graduation congratulations.

Health Service Update

Supervisor Schumann stated that there would be a speaker at the Township on June 29, 2010. The topic will be nutrition.



The bills of the Town Fund were passed for approval by the Board.

Trustee Poulos made the motion to approve the audit of the Town Fund bills. **Trustee Ryan** seconded the motion. Roll call was taken. Ayes: Trustees Carbonara, Poulos and Ryan, Supervisor Schumann. Nays: None, Motion carried 4-0.

Supervisor Schumann reported that the SouthtownStar reporter Joe Bisek called the office and inquired if the township had made any changes in the General Assistance Fund. Some township has changed their program to include other people. She will return his call to find out the details concerning this issue.

Trustee Carbonara made the motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:22 P.M.
