**3-3-1. AUTHORIZATION TO CREATE.**

The Township Board is hereby authorized to create a Veterans Services Commission.  
(2015 Code)

**3-3-2. COMPOSITION.**

If the Township Board creates a Veterans Services Commission, it shall consist of five members, at least three (3) of whom shall be current or former veterans of the United States Armed Forces. (2015 Code)

**3-3-3. APPOINTMENT AND TERMS OF OFFICE.**

- A. Members shall be appointed by the Township Board.
- B. The terms of the initial members of the commission shall be one (1) for one (1) year, two (2) for two (2) years and two (2) for three (3) years. Succeeding members shall serve three (3) year terms. (2015 Code)

**3-3-4. OFFICERS.**

The members of the Commission shall select one of their members to serve as Chairman and may select other officers as they deem necessary. (2015 Code)

**3-3-5. PROVISION OF PROGRAMS TO ASSIST VETERANS.**

The township Veterans Services Commission shall assist veterans of the United States Armed Forces in locating government or private programs to combat and prevent homelessness or destitution and for medical and health services. (2015 Code)

**3-3-6. COOPERATION WITH OTHER GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES.**

The township Veterans Services Commission may cooperate with other governmental entities and with any other organizations, associations, agencies, or persons in fostering, developing, and providing local programs designed to assist veterans of the United States armed forces. (2015 Code)

**3-3-7. CONTRACTING FOR SERVICES.**

The township Veterans Services Commission, with the approval of the township board, may contract with other governmental entities and with any other organizations, associations, agencies, or persons to provide programs for the assistance of veterans of the United States armed forces. (2015 Code)
